#### Elkhart:

1. Guidance Ministries – Volunteer time available – Noon – 3 p.m. You can volunteer for 1 hour or all 3! Duties vary from Spring cleaning, sorting clothing and food pantry organizing. No age restriction as long as children under 16 years are with their parent or an adult.
2. Feed The Children – Volunteer time available – Noon – 2 p.m. Duties include packing boxes with supplies. Must be 12 or older with an adult due to a warehouse setting.
3. Church Community Services – Volunteer time available – Noon – 3 p.m. You can volunteer for 1 hour or all 3! Must be 10 or older with an adult. Duties vary. **\*\*Minimum of 6 must register**
4. Faith Mission – Volunteer time available – Noon – 3 p.m. You can volunteer for 1 hour or all 3! Duties vary. Must be 10 or older with an adult.
5. Servants of the Streets – Volunteer time available Noon - 3p. m Children with parents welcome. Duties include: painting, landscaping, spring clean up. Can also used a skilled carpenter and furnance repair person
